Greetings from your PACRAO Board! The Board just concluded their summer meeting in Seattle and wanted to share some information with the membership. Please see the articles below regarding the 2009 conference in Newport Beach and travel grants; a change in the PACRAO membership year; a new award; and enhancements to the Nominations and Elections process.

2009 PACRAO Conference Registration is Open!

Welcome Aboard and set your sail towards Newport Beach, California for the 83rd annual PACRAO conference at the Newport Beach Marriott and Spa from November 1-4, 2009. The Program Committee will have you "Sailing Toward Success" with an excellent schedule of member and vendor sessions. We have been able to include Barmak Nassirian from AACRAO to address Washington updates and LeRoy Rooker to provide FERPA training.

Three pre-conference workshops are offered on Sunday, November 1, 2009: Mini-SEM, Navigating HR issues, and AACRAO's Registrar 101. In addition, extended sessions will be offered on Tuesday afternoon: Electronic Transcripts, VA Benefits/Chapter 33, and FERPA Updates by LeRoy Rooker. We have planned an array of roundtable sessions so you will be able to network and exchange ideas with other colleagues.

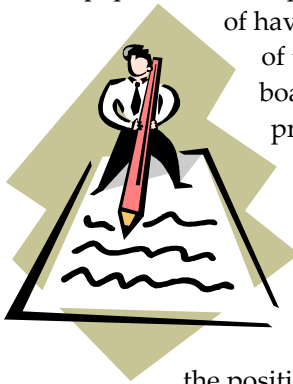


Changes in the PACRAO Membership Year

You spoke and we heard you! Somehow the PACRAO membership year is out of sync with the by-laws and the Vice President of Membership proposed that the cycle is brought back in line with the by-laws, which parallels most schools' fiscal year. The board agreed that membership renewal payments will be due July 1, but that a grace period would be extended to July 31 so schools have more flexibility with making the payment vis-à-vis their institutional budget.

Changes in the Nominations and Elections (N&E) Application Procedure

The board would like to automate the Nominations and Election process and make it less dependent on paper forms and physical attendance at the annual meeting. We would like to use the AACRAO model of having an on-line nomination form and advertise that nominations are open in advance of the conference. Members who are nominated for the N&E Committee or any of the board positions would be required to complete a nominee activity report listing their professional accomplishments. Instructions will accompany both forms stating any nominated, or self-nominated candidate, must complete the activity report. N&E Chair will monitor the nomination forms received and make sure all are accompanied by an activity report completed by the nominee. With the new process, the current N&E committee will have the information needed to make good nomination selections by knowing more about the qualifications of the candidates. Also, by the nominee completing the activity form, their acceptance and willingness to serve in the position will be already established and not require additional phone calls after the annual meeting and their selection by N&E.



Proposed Timeline:

- May 1st, send out e-notification to membership to nominate and instructions for completion of form and nominee completion of activity report.
- October 1st, N&E Chair ensures that all nominees have supplied his/her activity report
- October 15th, completion date and cut-off for nominations for next year. N&E Chair is responsible to provide all documents to N&E Committee during annual meeting for nominations selection.

- November Annual Meeting, N&E convenes at end of conference and decides on nominees for each position.
- Mid January meeting, N&E Chair presents to Board, slate of nominees for next year.
- End of January, N&E Chair contacts nominated officers for final agreement to serve and notifies the Board.
- May 1st, all nominees for N&E bios and pictures obtained, forwarded to VP for Technology for posting to website
- June, August, October; email reminders to membership to vote online.
