The 1988 PACRAO SUMMER SUCCESS SEMINAR for personnel in recruitment, admissions, and records will be held on July 18 and 19 at the Rippling River Resort and Conference Center. Located in a spectacularly "All Oregon" alpine setting of tall fir trees, lush fairways, and crystal clear rivers, Rippling River is nestled in the foothills of Mt. #### Dear Colleague:

Article VI of the PACRAO Bylaws calls for the election of five members to the Nominations and Elections committee. A ballot is printed on the reverse side. It contains the names of nominees selected by the 1987-88 committee. Each of the nominees has agreed to serve. You are invited to vote for no more than five (5) nominees by marking an "X" in the box by the name of each person for whom you are voting. Ballots with more than five (5) votes will be disqualified.

For PACRAO membership validation and in order for your ballot to be counted we must receive your ballot in an envelope from your institution with your signature in the return address portion of the envelope. The ballot must be postmarked not later than 1 August, 1988.

The five nominees receiving the most votes will serve on the 1988-89 Nominations and Elections committee. The next two nominees will serve as alternates. Ties, if any, will be resolved by lot. No member selected will be eligible to serve on this commute in successive years, or be a candidate for PACRAO office while serving on the committee.
