Slate of Officers for 1993-94

Roger M. Swanson, President-Elect

Roger Swanson is Associate Vice President for Student Affairs at California Polytechnic State University in San Luis Obispo. From 1972 to 1983, he was Dean of Admissions and Financial Aid at Arizona State



University. He has been a member of PACRAO since 1972.

A regular presenter and session chair at annual conferences, Roger was PACRAO Equal Education Opportunity Advisory Committee Chair and Program Committee member for two years. He served on the

Nomination and Elections Committee, and was the initiator and Co-Director of the PACRAO Summer Success Seminar since its inception in 1986. He co-authored the PACRAO Fellowship Program.

Roger was a two-year member and Chair of AACRAO's Undergraduate Admissions Committee, a frequent presenter at annual conferences, and CASE (Council for the Advancement and Support of Education) Interinstitutional Representative. For CASE, he chaired the Commission on Recruitment and Retention for two years, has presented at 16 CASE workshops and conferences, served on the CASE Curriculum Study Advisory Committee, and received the CASE "Crystal Apple" award for outstanding teaching.

He is co-author of a new book for CASE entitled *The New College Admission Recruiter: Guide to Survival and Success,* which was published this spring.

He was elected to chair the ACT Northern California Executive Advisory Board, the Central Coast Higher Education Coordinating Council, and the Santa Barbara City College Intersegmental Transfer Center Advisory Committee.

Melanie Bell is University Registrar at Gonzaga University in Spokane, Washington. Her career in higher education spans 23 years of service as Registrar/Associate Director of Admissions and
