Vice-President for Professional Development, Colm Joyce

The professional development report was presented. Thanks to Kathy Thomas for all of the help with webinars and reviews. In October, we released latest edition of our journal, PACRAO Review. We also hosted several online webinars and supported seven PACRAO Pals pairings. Thanks to PACRAO Professional Development Committee and Editorial Review Board. Thanks to Native Brothers and Sisters who presented and spoke at this conference. Quote translated from Gaelic: "Thank you. It was my pleasure and honor to meet you all. Vice-President for Membership, Michelle Dodge

The membership report was presented. As of October 31st, we have 2,146 members from 239 active institutions. We've maintained the total number of member schools but have less individual members. Still have 30 institutions who have not renewed their memberships. We will continue working with primary contacts. We had a pre-session on Sunday with primary contacts. We do have voting cards if needed later this morning.

Vice-President of Publication and Information Technology, Kathy Thomas

This Kathy's outgoing year. Thank you to membership and board for an enjoyable two years.

Acting Treasurer, Marc Booker

The financial/budget report was presented: current budget view and new budget view. (Written reports were distributed to tables.) The new view has been adopted by the board. See Appendix A. Marc reviewed a PowerPoint that covered revenue and expenses. Numbers are inflated because all conference expenses have not yet hit the accounts. Changes to budget and accounting include:

- Bank account management changes
- Adjustments to how revenues and expenses are classified

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- Enhanced budget planning at the winter meeting
- Providing a direct view into the P&L of annual meetings
- Re-alignment of the conference ledger to match accounting software and consolidated financial statements.

Marc reviewed the benefits of these changes and stopped to take questions. Marc's tenure on board is concluding. It has been his honor and privilege serving you all.

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Audit Committee, Jan McCuen

The audit report was presented. (Written reports were distributed to tables.) Committee met with the Board at the winter meeting last February. All information is in report. There were two minor findings. We really applaud the new budget view. Any questions? None. Everyone on the Board is very fiscally responsible.

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Past-President, Heather Chermak

Announced locations for future conferences. For 2020, we've selected Seattle, Washington. We'll be downtown at a brand new hotel. Next year in Sacramento. In 2019, we're in Scottsdale, AZ.

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Nominations and Elections Committee - Heather Chermak

At the opening session, we heard the nomination slate for the year. Thanks to the committee: Jared Forell (2017 Vice-Chair), Erin Webb (2018 Vice-Chair), Lisa Erck, Mike Jefferis, Nikol Roubidoux, Melissa Thomas, Arturo Torres. Presented the slate of nominees once again:

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- Chris Sweet President- Elect
- Steve Downing Vice-President of Publication and Information Technology
- Krista Lough Treasurer

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A motion was made by Becky Bitter and seconded by Laura McKenzie to elect the nominees as presented. No discussion. The nominees were unanimously approved and congratulated.

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New Business

- Bylaw changes were presented. Proposal is highlighted text.
- Article IV Terms of Offices
- Section 1. Terms

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The terms of office for all elected officers of the Association, with the exception of the President-Elect, shall be for two years. The President-Elect serves three consecutive years on the Executive Board. A President-Elect is elected annually, with the Treasurer and Vice President for Publications and Information Technology being elected on alternate years from the Secretary, Vice President for Membership and Vice President for Professional Development.

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The elected members of the Nominations and Elections Committee shall serve for one year, except for the member who received the most votes. That individual serves for two years and serves as the Vice Chair of the Nominations and Elections Committee the second year. However should any annual conference be cancelled (or the time for it changed), the interval between two consecutive conferences shall be counted as one year in the administration of the provisions of this section.

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Section 2. Calendar

All officers, except the Treasurer, shall hold office from the adjournment of the formal annual business meeting in which they were elected until adjournment of the formal annual business meeting in which their successors are elected. The Treasurer shall hold office for two fiscal years, beginning February 1.

Section 3. Vacancies

In the event of a vacancy in the office of the President, the President-Elect will succeed to the presidency. In the event of a vacancy in the office of President-Elect, the current Vice President for Professional Development will succeed to that the position of President-Elect and then to the presidency. In the event that the Vice President for Professional Development is unable to fulfill the President-Elect vacancy, the succession to fill that position will proceed to the first board member who is able to in the following order: Vice President for Membership, Secretary, Vice

President for Publications and Technology, Treasurer, Diversity Development Advocate, and then Business Partner Liaison.

In the event of a vacancy in the offices of the Vice President for Professional Development, the Vice President for Publications and Information Technology, the Vice President for Membership, the Treasurer or the Secretary, the Executive Board may appoint a current Executive Board member to assume those responsibilities, or may appoint another person from the eligible membership, to serve the remainder of the term. In the event of a vacancy in the office of the Past President, the next most recent and willing Past President will be appointed by the President.

In the event of a vacancy on the Nominations and Elections Committee, after utilizing the two alternates, the President may appoint a person from the eligible membership. In the event that a situation arises which is not covered by the succession process outlined above, the Executive

Board may appoint an eligible active member to fill the vacancy.

A motion was made by Todd McCollum and seconded by Stephen Shirreffs to amend the bylaws as presented. No discussion. The bylaw amendment was approved by membership.

Closing Comments, James Miller

Four members of the board will be concluding their service: Marc Booker, Acting Treasurer; Heather Chermak, Past-President; Kathy Thomas, Vice President for Publications and Information Technology; and Ruth Garay, Diversity Development Advocate. We're so appreciative of their service. Chris Sweet is also concluding service as the Business Partner Liaison and James is stepping down as President. Membership has been so supportive. Thanks to you all.

James presented the gavel to incoming President, Rayanne Williams.

2017-18 President, Rayanne Williams

Rayanne presented James with a plaque. Theme next year: *Capitalizing on our Potential*. Things we'd like to do this year: keep looking at financials and make that more transparent, PACRAO Leadership Institute, looking at our technology tools and a website refresh. We need to think about long-term planning for PACRAO (next 5-10 years). President-Elect Sweet and others will also help move this forward.
