Budget Update

The PACRAO 2022-2023 fiscal year closes on January 31, 2023. In preliminary numbers, the organization currently has total assets of \$372,446.86. This reflects a loss of \$9699.65 from this time last year. However, \$5000.00 of that "loss" is technically a prepayment deposit for our 2024 conference location, which will be credited against our amount due in 2024. So, all being said, the organization remains in solid financial standing.
